This regular board meeting of the Board of Directors of the Red Oak Community School District was called to order by President Lee Fellers at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

President Lee Fellers moved eighth grade volleyball coaching resignation from consent agenda to Personnel Update and moved Principal Jedd Sherman, Block Scheduling to Curriculum Council Progress Report. Director Dilley moved, Director Schmid seconded to approve the agenda as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

EDUCATIONAL TRIP

Principal Barb Sims and grade four instructors gave a proposal to the Directors for a school trip to Springbrook Education Center. Students' admission will be paid by donations from Pheasants Forever and the Montgomery County Soil and Water Conservation. Director Dilley moved, Director Griffen seconded to approve the proposal for the Springbrook Education Center Trip with the district paying for the teachers' admission. The motion carried unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

Director Schmid moved, seconded by Director Griffen to approve the consent agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

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NEW BUSINESS

PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was conducted for the 2011–2012 school budget at 6:15 p.m. There were no questions or comments from the public. Director Hayes moved, Director Dilley seconded to approve the school budget for the 2011-2012 school year as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

SCHOOL CALENDAR

A public hearing was conducted for the 2011-2012 school calendar at 6:30 p.m. There were no questions or comments from the public. Director Dilley moved, Director Hayes seconded to approve the School Calendar for the 2011-2012 school year as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

CURRICULUM COUNCIL

Director of Curriculum Barb Sims provided an update from the Red Oak Curriculum Council. It is projected the Council will recommend a comprehensive literacy program for kindergarten through the upper grades at the May 9 regular board meeting. Included with Sims' report was an update on the successes observed with the new literacy coaching position held by Instructor Norma Fast.

SCHOOLS IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE

Curriculum Director Barb Sims reported on the compliance visit by the Department of Education

as a result of the Schools in Need of Assistance Program (SINA). The visit reflected a positive summary report that demonstrated Red Oak Schools are following and exceeding the plan of improvement as outlined.

BLOCK SCHEDULING STUDY

Red Oak High School Principal Jedd Sherman along with several teachers provided an update to the governing body concerning its study of block scheduling. The Board affirmed its goal to have a review of student data regarding achievement not later than the June 13 board meeting. It is the Board's intent to make a decision regarding block scheduling no later than late fall of 2011.

DISTRICT COMPUTER 1:1 INITIATIVE

Media Specialist Janelle Erickson provided a progress report for the Computer 1:1 Initiative underway in the Red Oak Schools. A team of several staff with Board representation is preparing for a project to provide all secondary students with computer technology on an individual basis.

PERSONNEL UPDATE

Volleyball coaching positions have been put on hold until all available positions at the middle school level have been interviewed and completed. Interviews will be underway within the next two weeks for the positions of math, language arts, reading, social studies, and Assistant Principal/Activities Director.

Director Griffen moved and Director Dilley seconded to accept the resignation of Lois Bergren, Food Service Worker. The motion carried unanimously.

Director Hayes moved and Director Griffen seconded to accept the resignation of Brandi Merrick as Vocational Agriculture Teacher. The motion carried unanimously.

BUDGET EXPENDITURE REDUCTION PLANS/REVENUE ENHANCEMENTS

School Budget Expenditure Reduction Plans and Revenue Enhancements for FY 12 were discussed. The Board of Directors reviewed preliminary plans by school administrators to reduce budget expenditures in the 2011–2012 school year by an estimated \$250,000. It is planned to accomplish this by the reduction of one leadership position, realignment of administrative duties, through the consolidation of one mathematics position, and through the employment of new teaching staff which could have a smaller fiscal note than teachers retiring or moving from the district.

POLICIES REVIEW AND UPDATES

As part of the board's five year cycle of policy review, Director Dilley moved, Director Hayes seconded to approve the first reading of board policy code 102 Equal Educational Opportunity as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

EMPLOYEE MANUAL UPDATE

Brief discussion was given to the draft copy of the proposed Red Oak Employee Manual. Continued discussion will continue at future meetings until the manual is ready to implement on July 1, 2011.

ADJOURNMENT

Director Schmid moved, Director Griffen seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m. The next Board of Directors meeting will be held on Monday, April 25, 2011 at 6:00 p.m., in the Sue Wagaman Board Room at the Webster Building. The motion carried unanimously.

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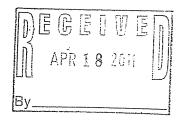

GENERAL FUND

* The balance is actually \$1,202,197 but since \$184,233 is Ed Jobs money and \$28,732 is REAP money that are both a one time payment just for this year I subtracted that amount out for a more true picture for when we compare in future years. I did the same thing last March with the ARRA (American Recovery And Reinvestmen Act) money. Explanation for the increased balance is due inpart to staff retirements, closely monitored budgets, and the Cash Reserve Levy that was passed in April. THIS IS ALL VERY GOOD NEWSIIII

MANAGEMENT

This fund had large expenditures this quarter due to paying early retirement in January.

PHYSICAL PLANT AND EQUIPMENT "PPEL"

** This balance is altered due to the purchase lease agreement for the new busses. (\$295,504) Without the agreement the difference is \$13,145. However since this is a known liability I thought it best to show it on this report. \$25,014.10 will be used from this fund for the Debt Service payment due in May.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

Revenue in this account has increased tremedously due to the one cent sales tax going state wide. 2010 revenue received by March. 31st = \$310,239 2011 revenue received by March. 31st = \$485,533 Increase of \$175,294 In May \$378,870 will come from this fund to pay towards the 2000 building project.

This account is showing an increase of \$26,160. This is interesting since at the end of December there was a decrease of \$9,971. This could be reflective of when state and federal funds were received.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Needless to say interest rates have much to do with this account.

We were notified by the law firm that had been handling the Murphy Scholarship that there were funds available

in the account but they no longer wanted to handle the funds. They stated the account was not generating enough

interest to pay their fees. Therefore they wanted to give the money to the school for them to handle. In checking back I found money has not been paid from this account for at least 10 years,

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Contract considerations should be given this evening for auditing services in the Red Oak CSD. Enclosed is background material prepared by Shirley. Please allow a few minutes for her presentation.

SUGGESTED BOARD ACTION: (to be determined)

Schools are required by the Iowa Code to send out requests for proposals for the district's annual fiscal audit. This is the year that the Red Oak School District needed to request these proposals. We sent out letters to 5 different auditing firms requesting a proposal for the 2010-2011 audit. (letter enclosed) Of the 5 sent out, three firms responded. Bruce Frink, Nolte, Cornman & Johnson, P.C., and Bohnsack & Frommelt LLP.

All firms were sent the same letter and packet of information of what we require in our audit. Following is a condensed form of their proposals. All information is in my office if you wish to stop by and see them or I will be glad to send them to you if you request. We requested all firms to give us a one year quote and a three year quote.

Bruce Frink-He has done the audits in the Red Oak District for several years. Clarion, lowa

Quote for year ending June 30, 2011 \$7,000

If we agree to a three year contract rates are as follows:

June 30, 2011-\$6,800.00 June 30, 2012-\$7,100.00 June 30, 2013-\$7,400.00

This quote is estimated on 60 hours @ \$125. It states total reimbursement shall not be for more than, \$7,000 for the June 30, 2011. However in the past there has been an additional charge for assistance with the Certified Annual Report. I contacted his office today and was told that yes, there could be additional charges if it took over 15 minutes to assist on the Certified Annual Report. Last year the additional charge was \$400. These additional charges started around 07-08 and seem to increase about \$50.00/year. Hourly rate-\$125.00

I asked about additional charge for a telephone conference call for the audit report to the board and he stated there would be no charge since it would be for such a short period of time.
